Class Description

This class is for beginning though advanced bobbin lace students. Students will learn Flanders and Binche bobbin lace techniques.

Materials

Prickings will be supplied by the teacher in class. If you would like your pricking ahead of time, please note this on your registration form. Please bring your own lace pillow, lace making tools and at least 60 pairs of bobbins or less, depending on the pattern. Patterns are designed for 80/2 cotton thread.

Class Fee: \$150

Coffee, tea, and snacks will be provided. Meals are not included. Many lunch options are located within walking distance of the museum, or you feel free to bring your own. Museum staff will be available to assist you.

Extra study available for \$50 per day Fri. 16th and Monday the 19th.
